The final periodic report is also underway and will complete the material which we will provide to the reviewers in time for the final project review on 8 and 9 July 2008.

In parallel with this demanding work, the signature of the Grant Preparation Forms for EGEE-III, a precursor to the signature of the Grant Agreement, is underway and the Consortium Agreement between all participating institutes is nearing completion. We have also received a draft Grant Agreement that confirms the beneficiaries, Joint Research Unit members, responsibilities and budgets. All tools, webpages and reporting requirements are being prepared for a smooth transition between both projects. The Project office is also fine tuning the agenda for the EGEE-III / EGEE-III transition meeting due to be held at CERN on 6 and 7 May, aimed at all institute representatives, be they beneficiaries or Joint Research Unit members, as well as activity representatives. Registration for this event opened on 12 March and will close on 26 April. Places are limited so we have foreseen videoconference facilities for those who prefer to attend remotely.
