

Dear EGEE-III project members,

I hope you have all enjoyed excellent holidays and send you all my best wishes for the coming year.

As we begin 2009 the project turns its focus to a smooth transition from EGEE to the European Grid Initiative. Later this month, an all-activity meeting in Brussels will start developing the detailed plans for each activity to ensure that all is in place when EGEE ends in Spring 2010.

During the 4th User Forum in Catania, Italy, 2-6 March, the implementation plan will be further refined, with several EGEE-hosted workshops dedicated to transitioning. The program is co-organized with Open Grid Forum and OGF-Europe. The work of these standardisation bodies will be crucial to the success of EGI. This event will give grid researchers and end-users the opportunity to follow and contribute to standardisation developments.

Additionally, this annual User Forum is the premier event for showcasing scientific results enabled through the EGEE Grid. This year about 180 abstracts were received in topics ranging from archaeology to on-line video streaming.

Reviewers are nominated and the dates are set for the first EGEE-III review, to be held 24-25 June at CERN in the Council Chamber. The first rehearsal is scheduled for 3-4 June, the final dress rehearsal for 17-18 June. Both rehearsals will be held in the IT Auditorium at CERN with video conference facilities.

Again, as a reminder, on 26 September, on the way home from EGEE'08, EGEE-member Fabio Farina suffered a serious accident. A branch fell on him, and his spine was badly injured.
