EGEE Industry Forum

The EGEE Industry Forum (IF) is an integral part of EGEE, designed to give Industry the opportunity to learn about EGEE and the latest developments in the Grid field as well as a means for industry to pass its requirements to the project, ensuring EGEE's industrial relevance.

In addition to meetings and presence at events such as the EGEE conferences, the IF organises special Industry Days and maintains a dedicated section on the EGEE web portal, geared towards the interest and needs of industry.

Industrial Applications on the EGEE infrastructure

EGEE already supports several successful industrial applications, from a seismic processing solution to applications from SMEs in biotechnology and the plastic industry, providing access to a large pool of resources attached to the EGEE Grid. Representatives of these industrial applications form the Industry Task Force (ITF), and interact with the technical boards and activities of the EGEE project on an equal footing with representatives from scientific applications.

EGEE Business Associates

The new EGEE Business Associate (EBA) programme provides opportunities for companies to engage in technical work in collaboration with EGEE, such as coordinated technical developments, market surveys, exploitation strategies or more general transfer of know-how and services to industry. As an EBA, companies also get early access to documentation, have the opportunity to publish articles in the EGEE newsletter, sponsor EGEE events and influence the programme of industrial events, as well as participate in the process to define a sustainable infrastructure to follow EGEE.
